Health risks: May irritate respiratory system and eyes. Splashes to eyes may cause irritation and damage.

Skin contact: Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.

Eye contact: Over-exposures of vapour are irritating to eyes. Splashes entering the eye will cause discomfort and possible damage.

Ingestion: May cause irritation, nausea and vomiting.

Inhalation: Over-exposures of vapour are irritating respiratory system.

First aid details:

After significant accidental inhalation: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. Keep casualty in a safe environment where there is fresh air. Seek medical attention if casualty doesn't make a fast recovery.

After contact with eyes: Do not rub eyes, as additional cornea damage is possible by mechanical stress. Remove any contact lenses and open the eyelid(s) widely to flush eye(s) immediately by thoroughly rinsing with plenty of clean water for at least 20 minutes. If possible, use isotonic water (0.9% NaCl). Contact a specialist of occupational medicine or an eye specialist.

After skin contact: Remove contaminated clothing, wash skin thoroughly with soap and water, or use a proprietary skin cleanser. Do not us solvents or thinners. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.

After significant accidental ingestion: If accidentally swallowed, Do not induce vomiting. Wash out mouth with water. Keep at rest and obtain medical attention.



Spillage and environmental:

Mobility: Store in an upright position and ensure container is tightly closed.

Accidental release: Do not discharge into drains or rivers. Contain the spillage using bunding then, absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by an appropriate method.

Avoid breathing vapours.

Clean residue with a detergent; avoid use of solvents.

Fire details:

Extinguishing media: Recommended - Foam, CO2 or Dry Powder.

Not to be used – water jet.

Recommendations: Fire will produce dense black smoke. Exposure to decomposition products may cause a health hazard.

Fire fighters should wear self-contained breathing apparatus.

Closed containers exposed to fire should be cooled with water. Do not allow run-off from fire-fighting to enter drains or water-courses.
